## Profile - Herm hordal - business manager

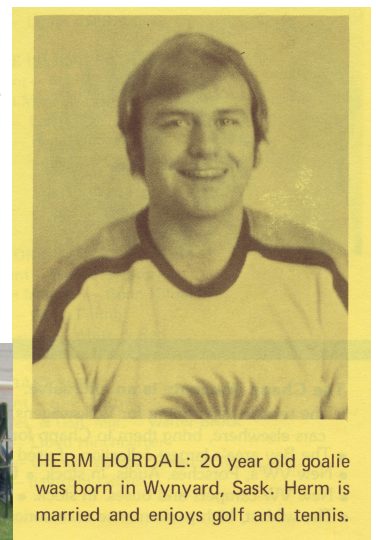
