Later, in post race technical inspections after the WSSL Auto Parts Super Late Model feature, second place finisher Trent Seidel was issued a technical disgualification when his LA Weight Loss Centres Impala failed a ground clearance rule. The SLM rules state "Side Panel of body MUST have 2" minimum ground clearance." The tech 'go/no go' tool did not pass under the side panel when checked. The DQ has cost Seidel in the points, dropping him back to fourth place. Jim Gaunt, Glen Hertzke and Greg Vangool are currently in a first place tie at 91 points.
