Hayley Cleans Up

Saskatoon race fans were treated to something different on Saturday night as the Baby Grand Racing Series made their first stop ever at Auto Clearing Motor Speedway. Though similar to Legends cars in size and power plant, the Baby Grand cars are modelled after Sprint Cup cars.

These cars, built at 2/3 scale of a full size car, are powered by a Yamaha 1250 cc motorcycle engine. The fiberglass stock car body gives the car aerodynamics not enjoyed by the Legends cars, meaning faster speeds.

Alberta racing sensation Cameron Hayley showed Saskatoon race fans what all the buzz is about around tracks in Alberta. Racing out of Edmonton International Raceway in Wetaskiwin, Hayley has shown a natural talent to race whatever he climbs into, despite the fact he just turned 14 in July.

In pre-race qualifying, Cameron Hayley timed in fastest at 15.555 seconds. To put 15.555 seconds in pack in the first Baby Grand heat race, leading all 15 Weenk timed in fastest at 15.361 seconds, Dan Shirley at 15.493 seconds. The pro truck track record is 16.746 seconds.

Cameron Hayley Wins Bryce Mann Memorial
