**Q. You're from a racing family. Who is your mentor at ACMS?**

A. There are many people who have helped me out over the years but my dad's always been a big part because I grew up watching and now trying to learn whatever I can from his past years.

**Q. What is the best advice anyone has ever given to you concerning racing?**

A. Best advice has to be just to take your time and let yourself learn how to drive the car instead of trying to go full out the first day.

**Q. What is your favorite tool in the garage or at the track and how does it help you?**

A. My favourite tool is the torque wrench so that all the tires stay on the car, because people sometimes forget to tighten them.

**Q. Are you required to do chores before you go to the garage? Which one do you hate the most?**

A. Usually we have to do the dishes and I think sometimes we should just leave them because race cars are much more important.
