Have you ever been watching a race and thought "I could do that," or wondered what goes on behind the scenes on race day? Here at Auto Clearing Motor Speedway we welcome both juniors and adults to get into one of our race cars and experience the track from a driver's point of view. Who knows, you could be the next Kevin Dyck, Cole Nixey, Audra Cooper or Sheetka Sister, racers who have all participated in the Junior Racing Program in recent years.

ACMS has three training cars, a thunder stock for the experience of a big V8 rear wheel drive, and two mini stocks for the experience of a light weight front wheel drive 4 cylinder. Both vehicles have two racing seats, so one of our local drivers can ride with you and provide advice. These vehicles were not always training cars, they were all owned by current or former racers at ACMS, and were used in ice racing and/or autocross, have won their drivers awards such as Most Feature Wins or Rookie of the Year, or were driven as everyday street vehicles before becoming a Championship winning race vehicle.

Getting involved with Junior Racing at Auto Clearing Motor Speedway is easy, simply show up to one of the scheduled days and we will get you in a race car. Our Junior Racing Program is designed to allow youth between the ages of 12 and 17 to become involved in our club, and the only cost for a junior member is the \$25 membership fee. Orientation not only includes seat time, but basics in automotive, such as changing tires, oil changes and usage of basic safety equipment such as jacks and jack stands. Many race teams at the track also welcome junior members as part of their pit crew, giving participants more racing knowledge and experience.

Auto Clearing Motor Speedway also gives adults the opportunity to see if they have what it takes to race, or to just gain a new appreciation of what our drivers experience on the track. Adult Orientation Days involve a 10-lap ride with one of our local drivers in one of the training cars, and then you get to drive for 10 laps, while our driver sits in the passenger seat. Our driver will show you where the best racing line is, as well as when to brake and accelerate. Pre booking is required for Adult Orientation Days, and the cost is \$20.00 per session, per car.

There is one more Junior Orientation Day scheduled for Sunday, September 14, 2014 at 12:00pm, and two more Adult Orientation Days, Sunday, August 17, 2014 and Sunday, September 21, 2014 at 12:00pm, weather permitting. We hope to see you there!
