

In this issue of Track Talk we would like to introduce you to Cole Nixey, a rookie in the Mini Stock division. You can get to know the driver of the #23 in the interview below:

- **Q.** When did you start racing at ACMS? Did you have any past experience? A. In 2010 I started racing go karts after watching Jared Reddekopp race. I also did the junior racing program for 2 years starting when I was 12.
- **Q.** What drives you to compete in the Mini Stock division? A. My dad raced Thunder Stock for a long time and I guess it's in my blood, and I want to try to do better than my dad did.
- **Q.** What are some of the highs & lows of your career or your first time at ACMS? A. Highs of my go kart racing career would be winning the Jr 1 Go Kart division championship in 2011. Highs at ACMS would be taking the Mini Stock out for the first time around the track! Lows would obviously be hitting the wall on the 2nd heat of my 1st race.



- Q. What are your goals for the 2014? A. To have fun and improve as much as possible, and maybe get the #23 on the leader board!
- Q. What do you enjoy most about your first time racing at ACMS?

A. The fans and how dedicated they are to racing and the track. Also, how after I hit the wall, a lot of the other drivers came over to me and said it wasn't the worst thing ever and told me about the first times they hit the wall.

- Q. You've participated in the Jr. Racing program. What team were you on and how did the program help you get to where you are now? A. I was on the Reddekopp racing team with the #15 and #17 Mini Stock. It helped me learn about what happens at the track and how to drive the car without stalling it every time I hop in! It helped me get a feel for the front wheel drive and taught me that you have to step on it if the backend slides out.
- **Q. You're from a racing family. Who is your mentor at ACMS?** A. My dad raced and growing up we watched him wrenching in the garage all the time with his crew. I have my dad to help with the driving part so I can learn the groove of the track and Quincy Richardson has put a lot of work in with my dad's cars and now with my set up and handling. His help will keep me from hitting the wall again...I hope!
- **Q.** What is the best advice anyone has ever given you concerning racing? A. My dad says, "always hold your line" and Jim Barnsley told me, "don't go out of your way to let us pass you, it's our responsibility to pass you safely".
- Q. What is your favorite tool in the garage and how does it help you?

 A. The jack because it helps with tires and working under the car, and you can ride it like a skateboard when you get bored in the pits.
- Q. Are you required to do chores before you go to the garage? Which one do you hate the most? A. I mow the grass but none really. I get in trouble if I'm not in the garage helping out though. I can't just show up to drive. I have to help get the car ready and fix it too. If Dad is in the garage, I am too. That's where I will spend most of my life this summer.
