

2015 "Run Your Junk" Rules

- THE IDEA IS TO BUILD A "*Run Your Junk*" (CAR WITH LIMITED MONEY AND LITTLE TIME.
- WITH A LITTLE HELP YOU WILL BE ABLE TO BUILD IT IN A WEEKEND.
- IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS ... ASK... DON'T ASSUME.
- SAFETY IS THE REGISTRANTS' RESPONSIBILITY.

These cars will run the Middle segment of the Enduro. This segment will be 75 laps or 45 minutes – up to the discretion of the race director. Some vehicles with enough safety built in (i.e. cages) will be allowed to run the 3rd 100 lap segment - up to the discretion of the race director.

- Open to:
 - 4, 6 or 8 cylinder vehicles
 - o 100" to 116" wheel base
 - front or rear wheel drive allowed
 - fuel injection allowed
- ¼ ton trucks allowed but not extended type or 4 wheel drive no Dakota's no convertibles no vans. If any questions ... ask.
- Absolutely ZERO modifications to suspension or engine. If it didn't come from the factory with it ... it is not allowed.
- No aftermarket parts allowed
- Street tires / street rims nothing over 8 inches wide
- 1 inch lug nuts recommended, especially right side
- No gutting or reinforcing except to allow for roll cage / roll over post or "c" channel along driver's door
- Cage is not mandatory, but if you so decide, 4 point only with NO bars extended thru the front or rear firewalls

- Minimum of two 4 inch "c" channel, or equivalent thereof (i.e. grader blade), along driver's side, <u>securely</u> fastened from "a" pillar to ahead of rear wheel well; weld and/or ready rod accepted
- Roll over post and "b" pillar reinforcement is the minimum requirement (see diagram)
- No locked rear diff's
- Driver's side window net mandatory
- Fire extinguisher mounted within driver's reach
- Disable driver's side air bag
- Fuel cells permitted; however, rear firewall is required seal all openings to the trunk (rear seat area)
- Factory gas tank can remain in its location & must not leak; if using a factory tank, no firewall is necessary
- Remove all:
 - Plastics, burnables, glass (except windshield), unnecessary rubber, mirrors, cladding, etc.
 - Plastic outer body panels to remain
 - You may need to modify fender to accommodate driver's side
 "c" channel on some vehicles
- Dash to remain intact
- Driver's seat to remain intact RUSTY SEAT MOUNTS MUST BE REPAIRED – seat MUST be secured. THIS IS CRITICAL.
- Racing seat preferred
- Factory lap belt with shoulder harness
- Weld or chain doors shut
- Hood chained or hood pins installed remove the factory latch
- Battery can be relocated but must be in a plastic or rubber container securely fastened and covered.
- <u>Fire retardant coveralls MUST be worn by drivers no ordinary</u> coveralls.
- D.O.T. or Snell approved helmets.
- Neck collar or Hans type device *highly* recommended.
- Dressing up of cars highly recommended NO VULGARITY!


If you are building – here are some tips:

- Heat is a killer be certain the radiators are functioning as best as possible
- The race will eat up brakes new pads are a good expense
- Cars that have been sitting, will have belts and hoses that may need replacing – DO THAT AHEAD OF TIME
- Bring **EXTRA** batteries / tires and rims / fluids (oil+ transmission)
- Mechanical gremlins take the fun out of it; try to eliminate as much uncertainty as possible before the event
- Utilize the website to ask for parts such as: window nets, fire extinguishers, etc.
- Utilize auto wreckers Brock Salvage is one of the ACMS division sponsors
- This is meant to be a fun event it is NOT NASCAR. If successful we will pursue this type of vehicle in the future in a much bigger way.
- When building keep in mind that we would like to have a handful of these types of vehicles to supplement the 3rd segment of the Enduro. "Run Your Junk" cars that move to the 3rd segment will receive NO prize money - just extra fun laps and a better show for the crowd. Cars that exceed minimum safety will be strong candidates.


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



O95 ROLLOVER POST, FLAT PLATE WELDED TOP + BOTTOM, BOLTED THRU ROOF + FLOOR
